**Domestic violence is a crime. You have the right not to be abused. You can develop a safety plan for the next time you are in danger.**

Think

Identify who you can call, a safe place to go and safety measures to protect yourself and the children.

Plan

Pack and hide a small bag with some money, extra keys, important phone numbers and medications. Leave these and other essentials with a trusted family member or friend.

Act

You can tell when violence is likely. Protect yourself and your children by seeking safety. Take action and leave before the next violent act.
